- Involvement in school and/or community activities

- One letter of recommendation (from other than relatives) must be submitted by May 1, 2024
- All questions must be answered completely.
- Include a copy of School Transcript and Activity Sheet (if applicable). The Activity Sheet should reflect school and community activities, as well as any awards and recognition you have received in these activities.
- Finalists will be announced by the selection committee at the end of May.
- Scholarship will be presented by June 30, 2024.
